**Montgomery County Sheriff Office Report:**

- Deputy Paul Cassidy introduced himself as the new community liaison officer for Montgomery County Sheriff's Office.
- Zone 7 was busy with a lot of traffic. There is a lot of outside population coming into The Woodlands along the 242 corridor.
- There were 338 total calls, mostly building checks and theft reports from Walmart. Harper's Landing area has been quiet lately.
- There was drop in burglaries both habitation and vehicle.
- There have been issues with graffiti, so if you see some in parks or on buildings take photo and report it to MCSO before reporting to parks, so they can investigate before parks department cleans it up. The graffiti may be gang related.
- The MCSO is completely reactive, there are 88 on the force while the population is the proactive part of the equation. Reporting crime is the only way they can solve it.
- The mailbox cluster theft was resolved. It was gangs in the Houston area stealing from mailboxes.
